


# Logging into Your Chromebook

1. Plug in your charger into the Chromebook.
2. Your device should power on after lifting the top cover. This means that it is charged.
3. However, if your device does not power on, then push the power button  on the upper right-hand corner of the keyboard to turn on your device.
4. Make sure that you can connect to your home Wi-Fi or the district issued hot spot (directions for using the district issued hot spot are included)
5. When your machine is powering on, you will see this screen:




6. Next, you will see this login screen




7. Enter **your district email address** as your username **into the** Username field. Click Next.
8. You will see a Welcome. Here, enter **your password into the** Password field. Click Next




9. After clicking next, you may see an “Agreement” screen. Click “Accept” at the bottom of the screen.
10. You’ll see the “All Set” Screen. Click the blue “Get Started” button in the lower right-hand side of the screen.



11. After clicking the blue “Get Started” button, you’ll be taken to the Google Browser. Here you can browse the internet or close out the browser.
12. To sign out, power down, or connect to Wi-Fi, locate your Chromebook System Tray in the lower right-hand side of the screen. Click on it. You will see this screen to perform the functions listed above:
