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Dear Parents and Guardians:

Public Act 101-0012 (ILCS 5/10-20.56) The State of Illinois provides for all students remote learning as an approach to teaching and learning during school emergency closings. In alignment with this expectation, Dolton East School District 149 is committed to ensuring that students in grades Pre-K-8 gain access to instructional material, support and on-going feedback from classroom teachers daily.

Recognizing the pressure that many families may feel during this time, our ultimate goal is to remain as flexible as needed to increase the likelihood that students experience success. In accordance with Section 18-8.05 of the School Code, “schoolwork” is conducted under the direct supervision of an educated licensed teacher. It is expected that a school district would use e-learning (and in the district’s case, remote learning) instruction with qualified personnel who are currently under contract with the school district.

A person holding a substitute license issued under section 21B-20 of the School Code (105 ILCS 5/21B) may be used in cases of illness or leave of absence. The ultimate goal of this plan is to ensure that (1) all students have opportunities for continued learning that focus on critical standards and (2) to ensure that students and families are given routines and structures to ensure that they stay connected to schools and learning.

The first day of school for students in Kindergarten – 8<sup>th</sup> grade is August 24<sup>th</sup>. Elementary School hours are from 9:00 am – 3:30 pm and middle school hours are from 8:20 am-2:50 pm.

All returning Pre-Kindergarten students will begin on Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am – 3:30 pm. All Pre-K screenings will be made by appointment only. Please contact Diekman Elementary School for a screening appointment at (708) 841-3838 Monday through Friday from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm.

Our overall goal is to keep students’ minds actively engaged with school and to connect with teachers. We know you will have more questions, as we continue to navigate through this new normal. Please be patient with us and know that we are all in this together.

## **TIPS FOR PARENTS TO SUPPORT STUDENTS WHILE WORKING REMOTELY**

- Eat a good breakfast
- Get a good night sleep
- Allow students to get dressed for remote learning daily
- Create a dedicated workspace in the home
- Establish a daily routine so children know what is expected
- Communicate with teachers if you have questions
- Allow your child to read to you and talk about the story
- Talk about what they are learning
- Encourage your child to do his or her best

## **PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLATFORM MICROSOFT TEAMS**

Professional development for staff will consist of the following:

- Administrators at the district and school level meetings will engage via Microsoft Teams weekly basis.
- All District Directors will conduct team meetings in accordance with a pre-set agenda.
- School principals and assistant principals will conduct weekly grade level meetings via virtually through Microsoft Teams and Zoom.
- School leadership meetings will be conducted via Microsoft Teams and Zoom virtually with a preset agenda.
- All staff in the district will participate in a Professional Learning Needs Assessment. Feedback from this survey will be used to customize professional development needs with teacher interest in mind.

## **STUDENT LEARNING SUPPORT**

All students will participate in full time instruction which will include a combination of direct instruction and independent work to support the 5 hours of instruction.

- Elementary teachers are expected to be available to contact parents and/or students between 9:30 am and 3:00 pm Monday-Friday. Middle School teachers are expected to be available to contact parents and/or students between 9:00 am- 2:30 pm.

## **FAMILY ENGAGEMENT & SOCIAL EMOTIONAL SUPPORT**

**Nurses, Social Workers, School Counselor and the District Psychologist will make contact with parents to check on student's mental health and well-being.** Parents are encouraged to participate with students with health, wellness and family engagement activities. For example: listen to your child read, cook a meal together, take walks, exercise and do a home project.

## **STUDENT LEARNING AFTER RECEIVING CHROMEBOOKS**

- When chromebooks are ready for distribution, parents will be notified (by email, phone blast, district website, etc) for pick up at individual schools.
- A distribution plan for chromebook pick up will be established for each building and shared with parents.
- Google Classroom will become the **main platform** for student learning after students receive their chromebooks and tutorial video, written instructions and via Zoom and Microsoft Teams.

Teachers have already participated in five days of Google Boot Camp training. Students and parents will receive basic training on how to navigate the chromebooks and how to maneuver through Google Classroom. Once the chromebooks are deployed teachers will assist students and parents in becoming comfortable with Google Classroom.

## **STUDENT ATTENDANCE DURING REMOTE LEARNING**

- ❖ Students will check in with their teachers (for attendance purposes) daily through one of the student learning platforms: (**Microsoft Teams, Zoom, DoJo, Remind App, or via phone**).
  - Middle School students will check in between 8:10 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.
  - Elementary students will check in between 8:50 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.
- ❖ Teachers will be responsible to have daily contact with their students through one of the student learning platforms.
- ❖ Teachers must follow up with any students that don't check in and report their absence to the school office and building principals.

## **TEACHER ATTENDANCE DURING REMOTE LEARNING**

- Teachers are expected to report for work as per the agreed Collective Bargaining Agreement.
  - Middle School teachers will report from 8:10 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
  - Elementary teachers will report from 8:50 a.m. – 3:40 p.m.
- The first 40 minutes of every day will be used for professional development, meetings or office time by teachers. **Elementary 8:50 am - 9:30 am and Middle Schools 8:10 am - 9:00 am.**

- Teachers are encouraged to provide optional work to support student enrichment and engagement as long as they discuss it with parents. This is especially important for primary students.
- Teachers will participate in another professional development needs assessment and the feedback will be used to ensure we are providing essential professional development that teachers need to be successful during the next school year while we are in Remote/E-Learning.

## **GRADING EXPECTATIONS**

- ❖ Students are expected to complete and submit their work according to their teacher's directions.
  - Work can be submitted via email, discussion with the teacher or other mode as established between the teacher and the parent.
- ❖ Teachers are expected to grade student assignments in accordance with the District's traditional grading policy.
- ❖ Teachers will need to be flexible with students and parents during this non-traditional school model while continuing to hold students accountable for their work.
- ❖ Teachers must continue to enter grades into the district Skyward gradebook.
- ❖ Student Interim reports will be mailed home Friday, September 25, 2020.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**PLEASE** read through the Remote Learning Plan fully. We have put together comprehensive information on Remote learning and believe most questions are answered on this page.

### **1. When does Remote/E-Learning Begin?**

Remote/E-Learning begins Monday August 24, 2020 from 9:00 am -3:30 pm  
TMS 8:20 am – 2:50 pm

### **2. What is the attire for Remote/E-Learning while at home?**

Students are encouraged to be school ready. If you want your child to wear his or her uniform so, they can feel a sense of normalcy, it is welcomed.

### **3. How long will Remote/E-learning last?**

We are looking at the first quarter, August 24-October 23 and we will assess the transmission data in our school communities to determine, if we need to extend remote learning to the second quarter which would begin October 26<sup>th</sup> - January 15<sup>th</sup>.

### **4. What will students do on Remote Learning Days?**

See schedule and minutes of daily instruction on page 2 for elementary and page 3 for middle schools.

5. **Will teachers take daily attendance and monitor students' progress?**

Yes, teachers will take daily attendance and use Microsoft Teams Virtual Program to reach the maximum of students who have electronic access until chromebooks have arrived. Once chromebooks arrive the Department of Technology will set up a deployment and parent pick-distribution plan. Teachers will keep a daily log of student attendance and parent contact

6. **What time should students check in?**

Students will check in with their teachers (for attendance purposes) daily through one of the student learning platforms: Teachers will be responsible to have daily contact with their students through one of the student learning platforms (**Microsoft Teams, Zoom, DoJo, Remind App, or via phone**).

- Middle School students will check in between 8:10 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.
- Elementary students will check in between 8:50 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.

7. **Will teachers be available daily?**

Yes, Monday- Friday. Elementary teachers are available 9:30 am – 3:30 pm and the Middle Schools 9:00 am – 3:00 pm.

If a teacher is absent, we will provide a substitute teacher for all students. Those who have electronic access will connect through Microsoft Teams and students who do not have any electronic access will be contacted daily via phone to work with teachers. Please make sure we have accurate cell phone and land line numbers.

8. **Will Special Education and English Language Learners and student support services continue?**

Yes, students will receive accommodations and services based on their individualized needs. Students with IEP's and English Language Learners will receive direct instruction and support. The students who have electronic access will utilize web based instructional programs the following platforms (**Microsoft Teams, Zoom, DoJo, Remind App or via phone**). Students who do not have electronic access will be contacted daily via phone.

9. **Will Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy be available for students with IEP's?**

Yes, one of these platforms will be used to support OT, PT and Speech. Microsoft Teams, Zoom and Teletherapy will be conducted via phone for those students who receive these related services. (**Microsoft Teams, Zoom, DoJo, Remind App or via phone**).

10. **Do Students have to turn in their academic learning packets?**

Yes, teachers will work with each student and parents on submitting work via screenshots, email uploads and direct instruction, contact for those students with electronic access and via phone individual student contact with teacher, parent and student.

All students are strongly encouraged to submit assignments to teachers via screenshots, email, text messages and phone conferences throughout remote learning in order to provide feedback and assistance.

All parents are encouraged to communicate with teachers regarding academic questions and concerns. **All staff emails are attached by schools.**

**11. Will Nurses, Social Workers, School Counselor and the District Psychologist contact parents to check on student’s mental health and well-being?**

Yes, our Pupil Service Team will make a concerted effort to check on students “at risk” and students who have health related challenges. Parents are also welcome to email nurses, social workers, school counselor and the district psychologists with any questions.

**12. What If I Do Not Have Access to the Internet or Electronic Devices?**

**Please inform your child’s teacher and provide a working phone number that the teacher can use to make daily contact with your child.**

**If students need their passwords to log on to WIN, Blue Streak and Stride Academy, please contact your child’s principal and/or the teacher via email.**

Please contact your child’s building Principal via email or phone. Review the attached teacher email list by school. Parents can begin picking up student learning resources for the first quarter on August 19<sup>th</sup>. Refer to the schedule on page 5 of this document.

All students have a district assigned email. Teachers will communicate your child’s email address during the first week of school. Parents who have access, via cell phone, laptop or computer may screen shot student assignments and email them for teachers to grade or contact your child’s teacher, via email. We will connect with parents as much as possible during each school week and document contact.

**13. Will parents be able to pick up free breakfast and lunch at designated schools while the students are on remote learning?**

Yes, Grab and Go Breakfast and Lunch will be available for parents who want to pick up breakfast and lunch for your children Monday through Friday at the following school locations effective Monday August 24, 2020.
